

AUTO 510: BASIC HYBRID POWERTRAINS



Description: A survey of today's hybrid powertrains. Hands-on experience performing scheduled hybrid maintenance services. Introduction to hybrid vehicle diagnosis and repair. Development of entry-level skills needed to work on hybrid vehicles in a professional environment. Transfer: CSU.

Eligibility: must provide proof of the following:

- Valid California Driver's License
- Copy of your DMV record
- Males 18+ must be registered for Selective Service

The HYBRID Automotive Service Technician Program is a 2.5 unit intensive program and is recommended for those students desiring a compact introduction to hybrid vehicle powertrain diagnosis and repair, with a focus on scheduled maintenance services as well as light diagnosis and repair. Completion of this course will make entry-level job applicants more attractive to prospective employers in the automotive industry.
